- *Examining the way in which Bipolar Disorder presents in women, its association with menstrual abnormalities, medication effects and psychosocial issues.*

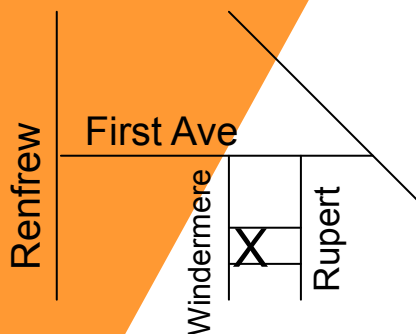
